



Liability Release Waiver and Safety Protocols

(May 31, 2022)

Due to the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19), Cello Day 2022! and Church of the Redeemer are taking extra precautions in compliance with CDC guidance and recommendations.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Dry Cough
- Difficulty Breathing

I agree to the following:

- I understand the above symptoms and affirm that I, as well as all household members, do not currently have, nor have experienced the symptoms listed above within the last 5 days.
- I affirm that I, as well as all household members, have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 5 days.
- I affirm that I, as well as all household members, have not

knowingly been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 5 days.

• I affirm that I have been fully vaccinated and boosted (3rd shot) with one of the FDA approved vaccines for COVID-19.

• I understand that Cello Day 2022!, Church of the Redeemer, nor any staff, organizers, volunteers, or anyone associated with Cello Day 2022! or Church of the Redeemer cannot be held liable for any exposure to the COVID-19 virus caused by misinformation on this form or the health history provided by each client.

Cello Day 2022! is following these enhanced Safety Protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

1. All participants must be fully vaccinated and boosted (3rd shot), and provide proof of vaccination (CDC card, email receipt from vaccination center, etc.). This may be emailed in advance, or displayed on the day of the event. No unvaccinated people are allowed in the venue.
2. All participants must be masked at all times while indoors.
3. Physical distancing of six feet or more is recommended. Each participant will be using their own stand and music due to distancing recommendations (no stand partners).
4. Food should be consumed outside. Water may be consumed inside, but the mask must be immediately replaced.
5. No food or drink is provided by the workshop or venue.
6. Windows are to remain open to provide ventilation.
7. It is recommended, especially for those who have traveled recently or been in at-risk settings, to receive a negative COVID test within 24 hours of the workshop. This is not required, but will provide an additional layer of protection for everyone at Cello Day 2022!.

By signing below, I agree to each statement above and release Cello Day 2022!, Church of the Redeemer, as well as any staff, faculty, and volunteers from any and all liability for unintentional exposure or harm due to COVID-19. Furthermore, I agree to agree to follow all of the safety protocols outline above. I understand that failure to do so may result in my dismissal from the workshop and forfeiture of tuition.
